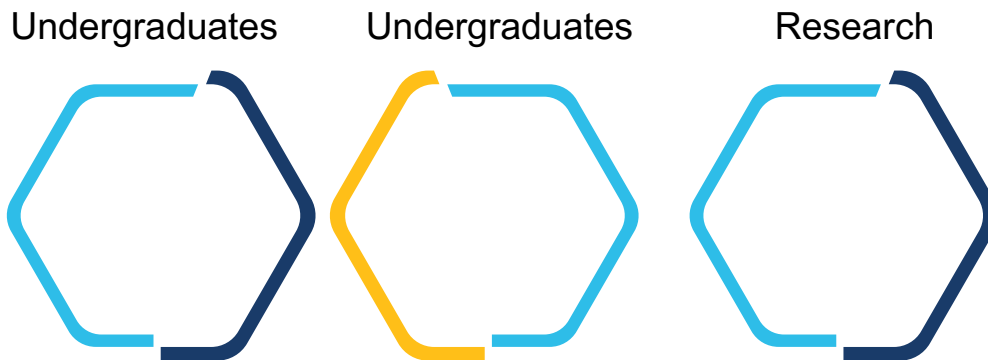

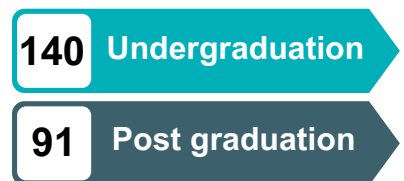

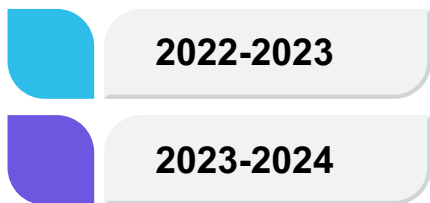

## Value added courses



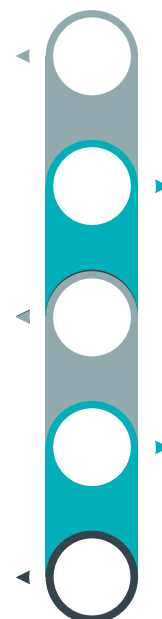
VICAS provides Value Added Courses to provide skill oriented technical training, with the primary objective of improving the employability skills of students. The main objectives of the program are:

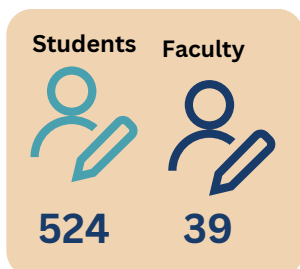

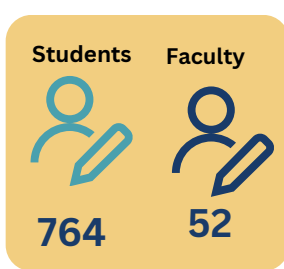

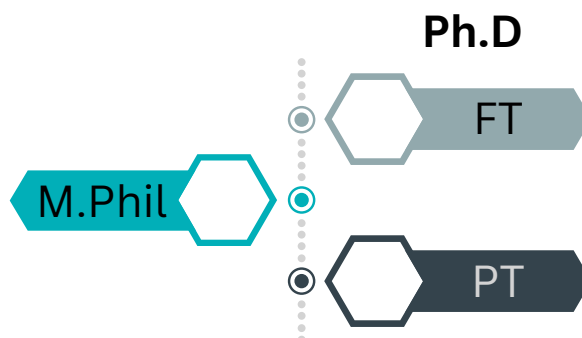

## Publications

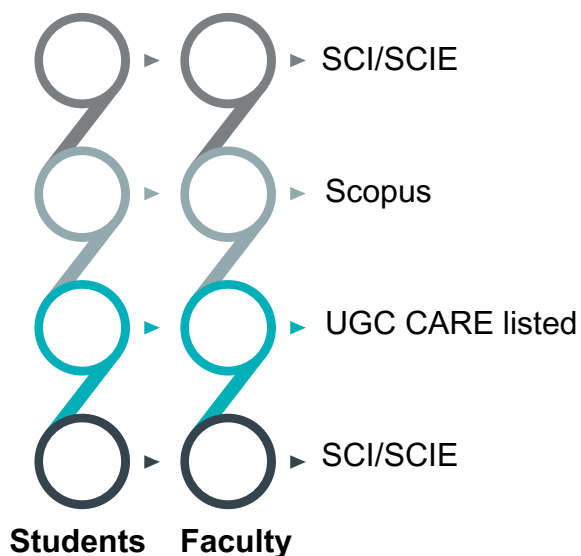


A total of 15 patents were published by the active researchers and faculty members.

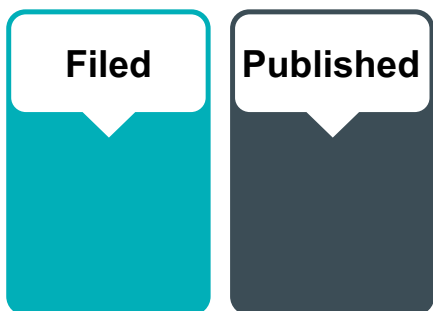
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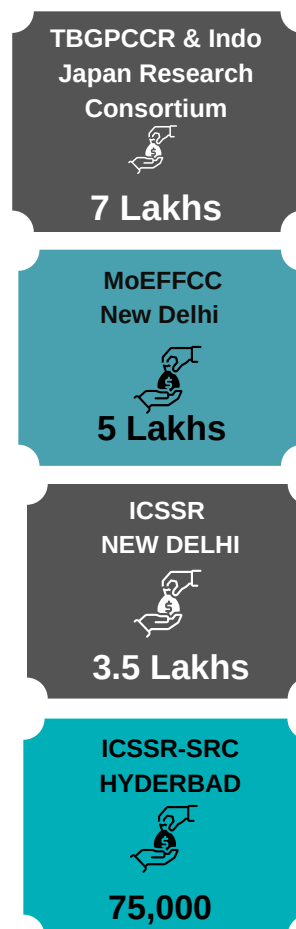

## Grants Received

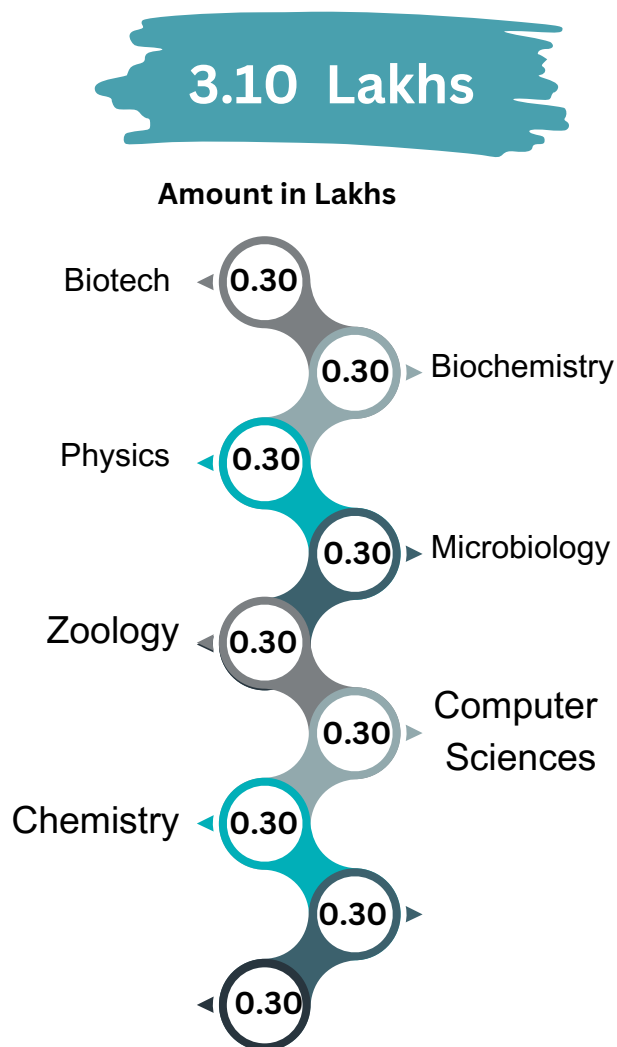

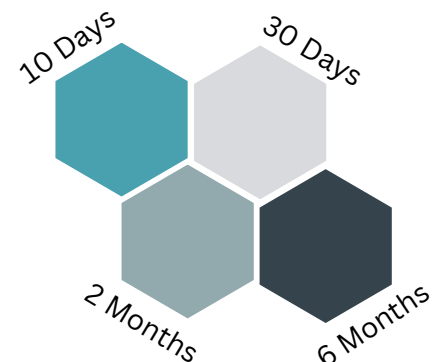
### Guest lectures and workshops Organized

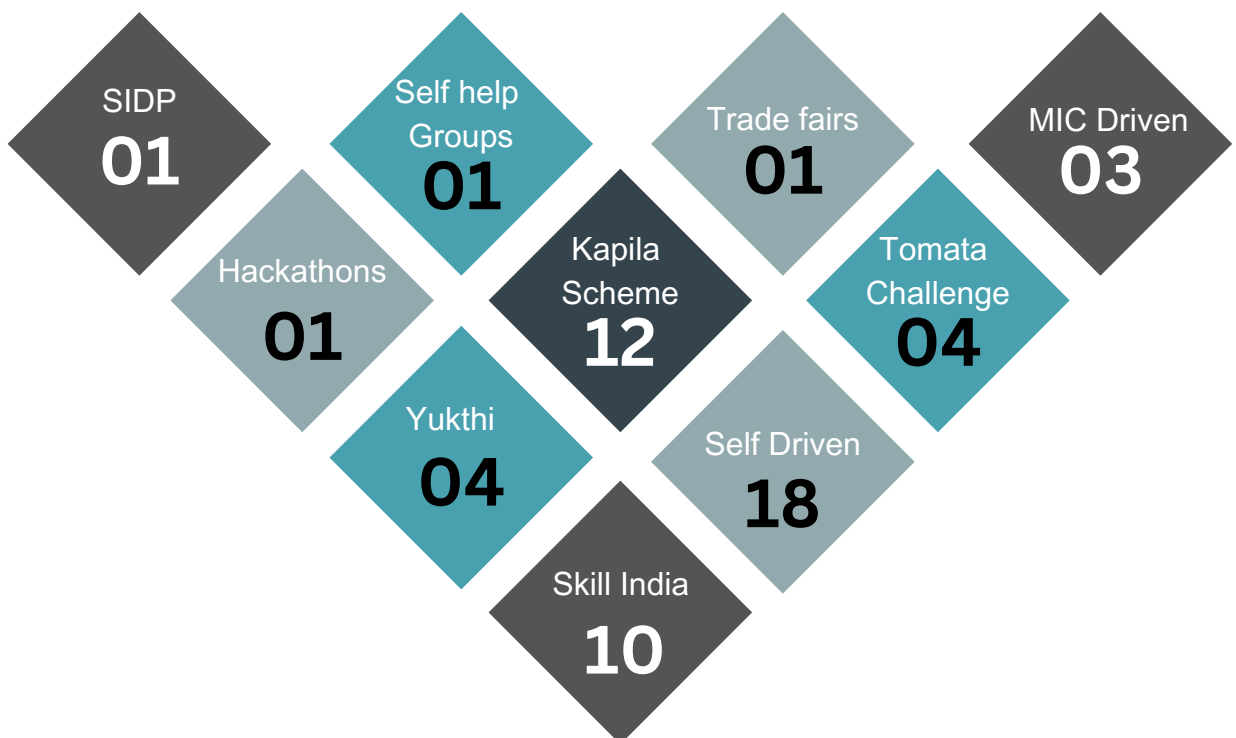
### Field Works (Projects/Internships/In-plant training)

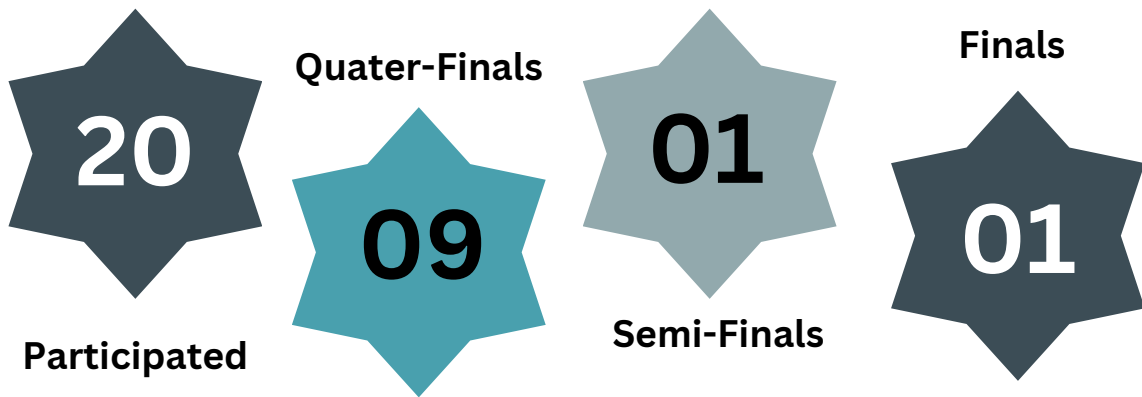

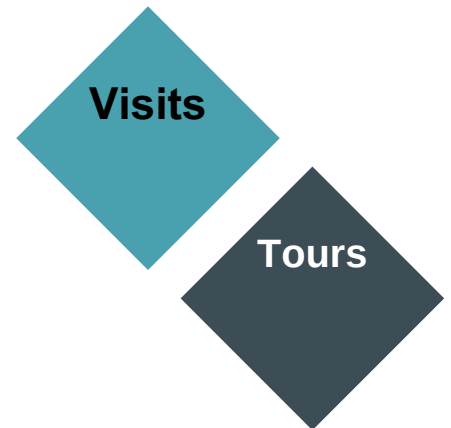

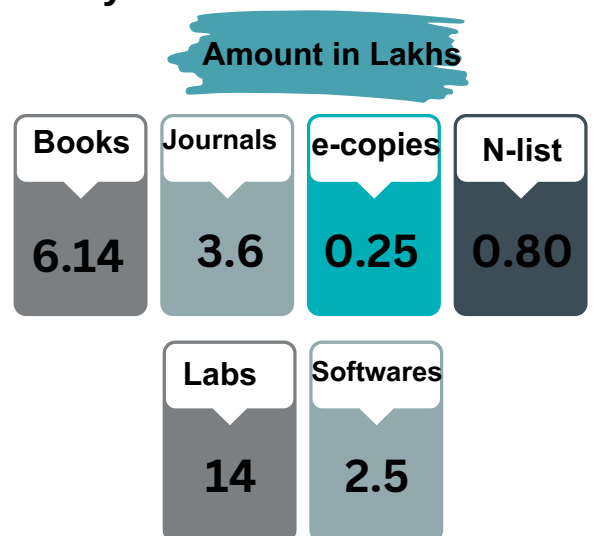
## Moon-light dinners

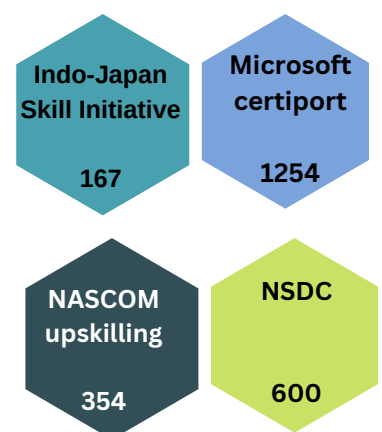
## Skill Development Courses
