SOLID AND LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

There is an efficient solid waste management system running in the College. The waste generated in the campus includes wrappers, glass, metals, papers, plastics, workshop scrap etc. are given for recycling to external agencies.

- Glass, metals, plastic and other non-biodegradable wastes are given to external agencies for segregation and disposal, recycling according to the nature of the waste.
- Leaf litter is collected and dumped in a pit, allowed to decompose systematically over a period of time to be used as manure for the gardens in the institute.
- Sanitary Napkin Incinerators are installed both in academic and hostel building to disposal of sanitary napkins.
- The liquid wastes generated in the campus include Sewage, Laboratory, Laundry, hostel and canteen effluent waste. The above waste is treated through Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) setup in the institute with a capacity of 12-15 Lakh litres per day. The treated water is used for watering the gardens and lawns maintained in the campus. The sludge settled in the STP is removed and mixed in vermicompost bed and used as manure for the gardens.
